## Driving Policy Emergency Vehicles

- 1. No unauthorized use of emergency vehicles.
- 2. Must be 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
- 3. Must be insurable.
- 4. No alcohol or drugs when operating vehicle.
- 5. Must pass driving test.
- 6. Engineers will be required at least 1/2 hr. driving time per month. Responding to and from calls will apply towards time.
- 7. A minimum of 1 hr. per 6 months night driving will be required.
- 8. No code 3 responses in our response area. Only during life threatening emergencies will code 3 apply, and only on straight stretches of road with a line of vision of at least 100 yards. Overhead lights and headlights will be on during responses.
- 9. Speed limits to be obeyed at all times and all traffic signs etc.
- 10. Engineers will operate vehicle in a safe and controlled manner at all times.
- 11. Engineers will NOT operate radio or phones while driving unless alone and then will reduce speed or come to a complete stop.
- 12. Once vehicle has arrived at scene, it will be parked in a safe manner and wheels chocked.

13.	Engineer will notify Fire Chief of any safety or mechanical problems
	immediately. Engine operations include fluid levels being reported if low, i.e.
	fuel, oil, water, etc.

- 14. Seat belts will be buckled at all times by all occupants.
- 15. Before backing up, a spotter will be in place.
