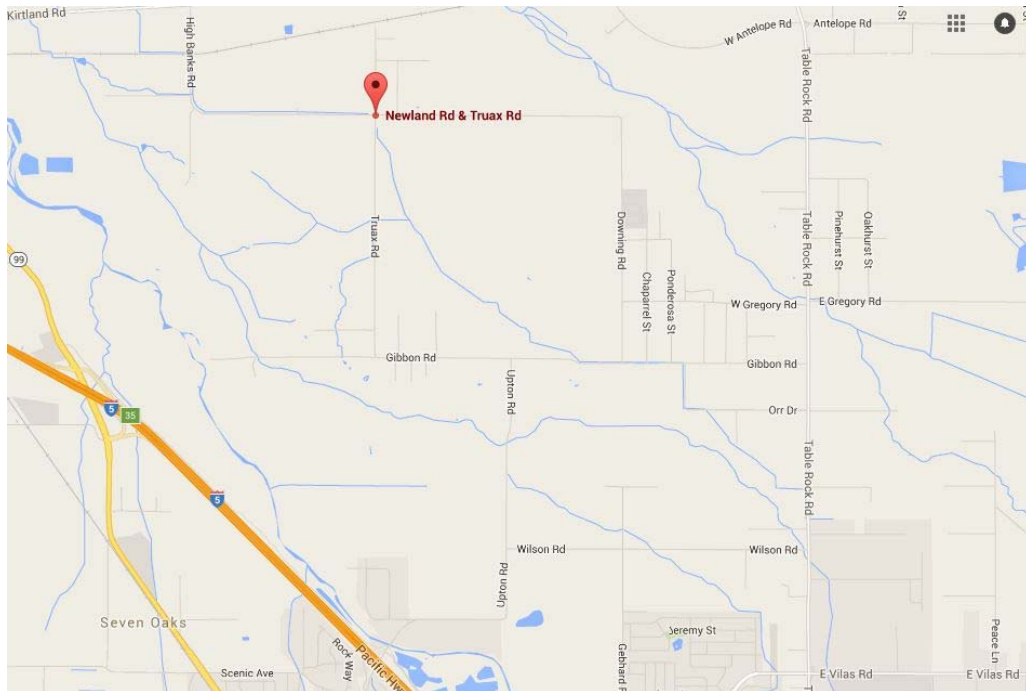

Fire crews from the Oregon Department of Forestry and Fire District 3 will participate in Live Fire Training on Thursday, June 23rd. The training will be at the intersection of Truax and Newland roads, Central Point. This type of training allows firefighting crews to closely mimic a brush fire in a controlled environment that the fire training staff monitors. Firefighters will work on mobile attack, pump-and-roll tactics, burnout operations, and fire ground communications to refresh skills needed for the upcoming fire season.
