



The National Weather Service invites weather watchers to a free severe weather spotter training program. The spotter class will be held Thursday, October 8th between 6 and 8 pm at the Carnegie Library. The library address is 413 West Main Street in downtown Medford. Attendees should enter on the 8th street side and go upstairs.

The weather service uses reports collected from spotters across the region to determine the severity of both winter and summer storms. Meteorologists will explain the types of storms we receive in Southern Oregon, show you how to use a rain gauge, and how and what to report.
